4.	Are flow arrows present showing runoff directions on the Existing Conditions and
	Drainage Plan sheets of the site plans?
5.	If applicable, check to see if "Berkeley County Roads & Drainage Review Checklist"
	has been completed, i.e. boxes checked.
6.	Is there a project narrative and does it include all project TMS numbers, the Total
	Area, the Disturbed Area and the impacted rights-of-way?
7.	For non-linear land disturbance of 5-10 acres, is a two-phase stormwater
	management and sediment and erosion control plan included?
8.	For non-linear land disturbance >10 acres, is the three-phase stormwater
	management and sediment and erosion control plan included?
9.	Do sites disturbing over ½ acre have temporary and permanent water quality and
	quantity BMPs?
10.	If no permanent water quality BMP is proposed, is a detention waiver included?
11.	Are sediment and erosion control BMPs shown?
12.	Is there a description of maintenance and a maintenance schedule?
13.	Does Total Area, Disturbed Area, and Impervious area match on the portal, site
	plans, CSWPPP, NOI and CAA?
14.	Are wetlands delineated?
15.	For projects over 10 acres, do sediment calculations meet 80% trapping efficiency?
16.	Is stormwater system connectivity clearing defined, including outfalls?
17.	Are stormwater calculations included?
18.	Is legend clearly defined, and does legend include all symbology shown on plans?
19.	Do elevations, pipe lengths, control structures, etc. match between the modeling
	calculations, drainage plan sheets and drainage profile sheets?
